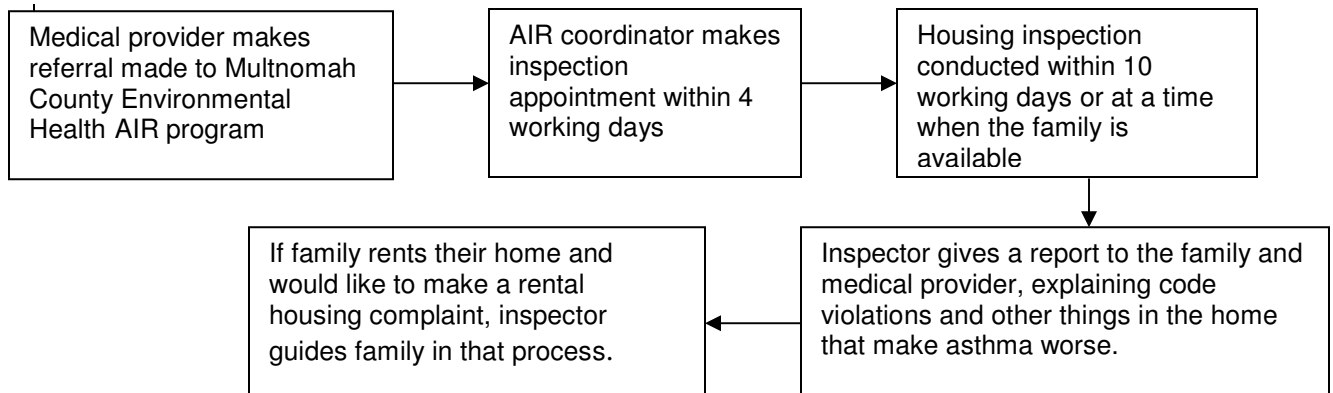


WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR AIR HOME INSPECTION

Below are a few things to know about your Asthma Inspection Referral program home inspection:

- Inspections are intended to assist people with asthma by identifying property maintenance code violations that are asthma triggers.
- We try to schedule inspections at dates and times that work for everyone.
- The inspector will look at all aspects of the home's compliance with the rental housing code, even those not related to asthma.
- Inspectors will address poor housekeeping when it contributes to asthma or housing code violations.
- The inspector will leave a report of her/his notes at the end of the inspection, including information about asthma triggers found in your home and how you can reduce them.
- The doctor or nurse that referred you will be updated by email and given a copy of the report when your inspection is complete.
