Executive Summary

\$3,500,000 will be set aside in the General Fund and maintained as a Stabilization Reserve against the year-over-year fluctuations in the Business Income Tax.

Program Description

The BIT Stabilization Fund will help to offset annual fluctuations in the Business Income Tax (BIT). The County has undergone mid-year budget adjustments in three of the past four years to address revenue shortfalls brought about by the economic downturn and reductions in state funding. This reserve will be available in future years and will help to ensure that County services can continue uninterrupted.

Program Justification

Maintaining reserves to stabilize revenues during economic downturns is a financially prudent thing to do.
