# **Executive Summary**

This program builds additional infrastructure to increase access and better utilize State and federal funding and to serve more people from the identified communities, more effectively.

## **Program Description**

Investment in culturally competent provider agencies to create additional capacity for mental health services will allow contractors to maximize funding, which includes obtaining a Certification of Approval for Medicaid funding. This will increase the service access and use by culturally diverse communities. In addition, this will allow the agencies to use the infrastructure created to serve uninsured consumers.

Further, as these culturally appropriate services expand accessing funds beyond Oregon Health Plan (OHP) and Multnomah County, additional federal and grant funds, will be possible. Ultimately, the entire mental health system becomes more responsive to the culturally appropriate needs of the diverse communities. The RFP selection process will involve community participation. Resources provided will include funding and technical assistance.

# **Program Justification**

The past three years, Multhomah County funded specific provider agencies and programs for delivering culturally relevant mental health services to African Americans, African Immigrants, Asians, Eastern Europeans/Slavics, Latinos and Native Americans. The funds awarded to agencies provided them the ability to build infrastructure and service capacity. The current funding level for services is insufficient for creating additional infrastructure that is needed for Multnomah County's diverse communities. Funding for infrastructure meets the community needs by being responsive to their mental health issues, being a resource for other community provider agencies and allows access for those community consumers that do not have any mental health coverage.
