Executive Summarv

Program places Oregon Health Plan-enrolled children and adults who are experiencing a mental health crisis in hospitals in order to safely stabilize their symptoms. The program is funded entirely by Oregon Health Plan. The average length of stay for adults is 8.3 days. The average length of stay for children is 7.1 days.

Program Description

Verity is the Mental Health Organization for Multnomah County residents with Oregon Health Plan insurance. Inpatient psychiatric hospitalization is one of the insurance benefits covered under the Verity Adult System of Care. The County receives State funding for this specific acute level of care. Admission for inpatient psychiatric care is based on medical necessity and clinical criteria. Inpatient psychiatric care is the highest level of psychiatric treatment necessary when community treatment has not been adequate to prevent a crisis or manage severe mental health symptoms. It is also the most costly level of care. The Multnomah County Mental Health Call Center triages admission to this level of care and ensures that coordination takes place between the hospital and community provider for smooth transition back to the community once an individual is discharged. With this level of care coordination, possible gaps in service are identified and referrals to appropriate service are made reducing the financial risk to the county.

Program Justification

Inpatient psychiatric care is a necessary service for individuals with mentally illness who are at risk of harming themselves and/or others and cannot remain safe in the community. While a Verity member is hospitalized, the Call Center communicates with the inpatient unit and coordinates community supports and services that will facilitate longer-term recovery in the community to prevent another crisis or readmission. The case management/care coordination component of this program supports the Basic Living Needs Outcome Team's request for offers that provide crisis intervention and coordination of services. By assuring emergency psychiatric healthcare, the program also supports the Outcome Team's request for offers assuring healthcare for vulnerable members of the community.
