**Executive Summary**

MCSO is the ORS mandated provider of courthouse security. The FSU provides such security as the frontline deterrent for disruptions or criminal activity in County mixed use buildings such as the Juvenile Justice Center.

Offer "E" adds two seven day per week posts at the Juvenile Justice Center.

**Program Description**

The FSU currently provides external and internal security to the Juvenile Justice Center through the screening and assessment of persons and properties entering the Juvenile Justice Center. Although the mandated duties of the FSU are only to the court, the FSU provides building wide response to disruptions and criminal acts throughout the non-detention or public portions of the Juvenile Justice Center Complex (JJC). The presence of uniformed MCSO staff acts a deterrent to persons who would otherwise endanger the public, staff and county property.

**Program Justification**

The public, County employees, and state staff want to feel they are safe when conducting business in county facilities. The JJC is a facility that conducts family court business, which can result in highly emotional and volatile confrontations. The business of the family courts does not just occur on the JJC court floor, but such business is conducted through out the complex. The presence of uniformed staff, trained to de-escalate volatile situations, is a primary element in maintaining a safe environment for the public and staff at the JJC.

This is "new" due to the emerging need to screen people entering the public/court areas of the building during non-court hours to maintain an environment sterile of weapons, which could be brought into the building and retrieved at a later time. This offer includes one-time equipment funds to add cameras and a recording system to these areas of the building. If the equipment can be installed, it is likely the need to staff this area on "graveyard" can be eliminated provided this area of the building is secured.
