Executive Summary

Multnomah County is completing its first Community Wildfire Protection Plan. This plan will provide a guide for communities across the county to understand their risk of wildfire and allow for coordinated planning to reuse the risk of wildfire and increase response capability for fires in the urban wildland interface. \$40,000 are requested to support this one-time effort to implement activities in this plan.

Program Description

This program will provide fund a temporary employee to begin implementing action steps associated with the Community Wildfire Protection Plan. These steps will include creating a model for coordinating wildfire education activities across the various fire districts and departments in Multnomah County; assisting with grant development that relies on information in the Community Wildfire Protection Plan; and working with county departments to implement internal actions steps as identified in the Community Wildfire Protection Plan.
